In our library, you can find books for every age and reading level, newspapers, magazines, comics and graphic novels, audio books, films, board games, tiptoi-media, Tonies-, and Kekz-items.

Visitors can use our three computer terminals to search our catalogue, pre-order items, extend loans and access their library accounts. Internet access and a photocopier are also available to all visitors. Free for all paid up library members is the brockhaus.de research site; the perfect accompaniment for school, studies and work.

The access to the library account is also possible from home or anywhere with internet. Simply log onto your account under www.buecherei-vaterstetten.de to research, pre-order, extend your borrowed items or find out about coming events and attractions. In order to login, simply use your reader number (on the back of your library card) and your date of birth (DDMMYYYY). When you first login, you will be reminded to choose a new password. You can request a password reset from the library team at any time.

When their annual library fee is fully paid, readers have access to our complete e-media catalogue, www.biblioload.de, at no extra charge; in the comfort of their own homes, on a PC, laptop, iPad or e-reader anywhere, anytime!

Events and other announcements can be found on our homepage, in regional newspapers, the local magazine "Lebendiges Vaterstetten" and on our social media platforms.

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To enrol at the library, we need to see your valid ID card. When children and teens under 18 wish to enrol, we need their address, and the signature and ID card of a parent or guardian.

Library cards are non-transferrable.

If a library card is lost, a replacement card costs € 5.00. Please bring your library card every time you wish to borrow items.

Borrowing times

Books, audio books, games, tiptoi-, Tonies- and Kekzitems can be borrowed for four weeks.

Magazines and films can be borrowed for two weeks. If you need more time, the borrowing time can be extended up to two times, as long as no other readers have pre-ordered the item.

Take advantage of our interlibrary loans

For academic purposes, fernleihe@vaterstetten.de is the right address. Fees of \notin 2.50 are charged per book. Library Network Ebersberg (BNE) gives all readers the possibility of ordering books from the local libraries in our regional network, when they are not in our Vaterstetten catalogue. Each order also costs \notin 2.50.

<u>Pre-ordering</u> of up to five items per library card can be done either by phone, online, at the computer terminals or personally in the library. It is possible to choose if you would rather be informed by email or over the phone when your orders have arrived. It is important to pick up your ordered items as quickly as possible, at the latest within one week. There are no fees charged for this service.

<u>Returning</u> books and other items can be done in two ways: either personally in the library during opening hours, or outside opening hours via our return box. It is possible to receive automatic reminder emails when items are due. This can be set up in your online account under settings "Einstellungen".

<u>Overdue</u> items acquire late fees; 30 cents per day and item for adults and 20 cents per day and item for the under 18s. In addition to these late fees, the first reminder letter costs \notin 2.00 and the second reminder letter costs \notin 3.00.

We hope that all visitors to the library take appropriate care of our items; this is of interest for all visitors. If an item is lost or damaged, we expect you to provide us with a replacement. If you realise at home that a borrowed item has been damaged, please contact us as soon as possible.
